Terms and Conditions

1. The Promoter

- 1.1. The promoter is: Genesis Motor UK Limited, Birchwood Building, Springfield Drive, Leatherhead, Surrey KT22 7LP (Company Registration 12224556)

2. The Competition

The title of the competition is: Genesis Scottish Open 2026 Event Tickets

3. The Prize

- 3.1. The "**Prize**" means the Prize consisting of fifty-five (55) pairs of General admission tickets to the Genesis Scottish Open, held from 9 July to 12 July 2026.
- 3.2. The tickets are one-day standard entry tickets, recipients will be able to choose their preferred day of entry, however please note that your preferred day may not be available and so an alternative date of the event will be offered as substitute.
- 3.3. Genesis will not provide or compensate travel, accommodation or subsistence.
- 3.4. Prizes are subject to availability. There is no cash alternative for the prize.
- 3.5. The prize is not negotiable or transferable.

4. How to enter

- 4.1. The competition will run from 12 noon on 22 May 2026 (the "**Opening Date**") to 12 June 2026 (the "**Closing Date**") inclusive.
- 4.2. All competition entries must be received by the Promoter by no later than 5 pm on the Closing Date. All competition entries received after the Closing Date are automatically disqualified.
- 4.3. To enter the competition, participants must accurately complete the entry form on genesis.com, thereby accepting these terms and conditions.
- 4.4. No purchase necessary.
- 4.5. The Promoter will not accept:
- (a) responsibility for competition entries that are lost, mislaid, damaged or delayed in transit, regardless of cause, including, for example, as a result of any postal failure, equipment failure, technical malfunction, systems, satellite, network, server, computer hardware or software failure of any kind; or
 - (b) proof of posting or transmission as proof of receipt of entry to the competition.

- 4.6. By submitting a competition entry, you are agreeing to be bound by these terms and conditions.

- 4.9. The competition entries will be awarded on a first come, first serve basis.

5. Eligibility

- 5.1. The competition is open to all residents in the UK aged 17 years or over, except:

- (a) employees of the Promoter or its holding or subsidiary companies;
- (b) employees of agents or suppliers of the Promoter or its holding or subsidiary companies, who are professionally connected with the competition or its administration; or
- (c) members of the immediate families or households of (a) and (b) above.

- 5.2. If you are under the age of 18 you must obtain written parental or guardian consent to enter and claim the Prize. The Promoter may ask the winner to provide proof of age.

- 5.3. In entering the competition, you confirm that you are eligible to do so and eligible to claim the Prize. The Promoter may require you to provide proof that you are eligible to enter the competition.

- 5.4. The Promoter will not accept competition entries that are:

- (a) automatically generated by computer;
- (b) completed by third parties or in bulk;
- (c) illegible, have been altered, reconstructed, forged or tampered with;
- (d) photocopies and not originals.

- 5.5. There is a limit of one entry to the competition per person. Entries on behalf of another person will not be accepted and joint submissions are not allowed.

- 5.6. The Promoter reserves all rights to disqualify you if your conduct is contrary to the spirit or intention of the prize competition.

- 5.7. Competition entries cannot be returned.



6. Winners

- 6.1. The decision of the Promoter is final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.
- 6.2. The Promoter will contact the winners of the competition and they will receive their tickets directly via the email address provided in their entry. The Promoter will not be responsible for the inability of a Prize winner to take up the Prize.
- 6.3. The Promoter will send the name and counties of the winners to anyone who writes within one month after the Closing Date of the competition requesting details of the winners and who encloses a self-addressed envelope to the address set out in Condition 1.

7. Claiming the Prize

- 7.1. Please allow 5 days for delivery of the Prize.
- 7.2. The Promoter will make all reasonable efforts to contact the winner. If the winner cannot be contacted or is not available, or has not claimed their prize within 5 days of the announcement date, the Promoter reserves the right to offer the prize to the next eligible entrant selected from the correct entries that were received before the Closing Date.
- 7.3. The Promoter does not accept any responsibility if you are not able to take up the prize.

8. Limitation of Liability

Insofar as is permitted by law, the Promoter, its agents or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate the winner or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking up the prize except where it is caused by the negligence of the Promoter, its agents or distributors or that of their employees. Your statutory rights are not affected.

9. Ownership of Competition Entries and Intellectual Property Rights

- 9.1. All competition entries and any accompanying material submitted to the Promoter will become the property of the Promoter on receipt and will not be returned.
- 9.2. By submitting your competition entry and any accompanying material, you agree to:
 - (a) assign to the Promoter all your intellectual property rights with full title guarantee; and
 - (b) waive all moral rights,in and to your competition entry and otherwise arising in connection with your entry to which you may now or at any time in the future be entitled under the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988 as amended from time to time and under all similar legislation from time to time in force anywhere in the world.

- 11.1. If there is any reason to believe that there has been a breach of these terms and conditions, the Promoter may, at its sole discretion, reserve the right to exclude you from participating in the competition.

- 11.3. These terms and conditions shall be governed by English law, and the parties submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
