





The Shutter Speed series showcases forward-thinking, unexpected ways that vehicles can be depicted. Produced in partnership with Genesis, *MotorTrend* gave three photographers complete creative freedom in how they depicted the G70 sedan and the GV70 SUV. As an extra bonus, all three participants were part of the Women in Action program. Their visions are as unique as they are awesome.

MEG MCMAHON

GV70 / LEBEC, CA / JUNE 14, 2021

Meg McMahon is a photographer who specializes in the world of cycling. She's especially interested in both the physical and emotional struggles that the sport requires. "I look for story, something in the expression—body language on the bike, the way they're moving on the bike," she said. "Whether it's a difficult moment or the environment is grueling, they have nothing else left, those images, that's what I like to capture."

McMahon ventured to Lebec, California, a community of the Tejon Pass region, to document professional cyclist Amity Rockwell. Together, they captured Rockwell gravel riding, a style that's in between road cycling and mountain biking, where speeds can easily reach 50 miles per hour. McMahon photographed Rockwell crushing some hills, sometimes through the open rear door of the GV70. The resulting shots, dusty and gritty, reveal that behind Rockwell's cheerful demeanor is pure intensity.

Down by the wharfs of San Pedro, she captured and helped choreograph a high speed car chase. Professional stunt drivers Ashley Cusato and Lea Croteau handled a pair of G70s, drifting and pulling 360-degree spins as they




Down by the ocean in Long Beach, California, Olivia photographed street skater Samarria Brevard as she attempted to ollie over the GV70. Brevard, who participated in the Summer Olympics as part of Team USA and earned a silver medal at the 2021 X Games, took on the challenge without hesitation. Before the GV70 was pulled in between the two custom-built ramps, Brevard took some test runs to calibrate her speed and placement in order to help Olivia pull off that one perfect shot.

When the time came, Brevard nailed the trick and Olivia got the pic. Brevard was stoked. "That one land, your day will be made," she said.

"That's why I do what I do," Olivia explained. "The skater's reaction to the image that I get, that means everything to me."
